



Futurity and Derby Rules & Payout



Futurity/Derby/Maturity Events

The futurity is open to horses five years old and younger. The horse cannot have been competed Dec 1 prior year. This includes play days, WSCA shows, AQHA, rodeos, etc. If proof is found that your horse has been competed on prior to this date you will be disqualified and your money will not be refunded. You will be banned from ALL SC Productions Events going forward

- No grade horses

The futurity will be 2 go rounds and an average. It will be a 2D format: full second split. Not time for a tipped barrel.

The derby will be 2 go rounds and an average. It will be a 2D format: half second split. No time for tipped barrel

The Maturity is open to any horse 7 years of age and under, OR any aged horse sired by a nominated MN Breeders Incentive Stallion – Check www.MNFuturity.com / Stallion page for nominated stallions, OR those that have run in previous MN Futurity OR MN Derby/Maturities will be eligible to run in the Maturity. They CANNOT compete in both the Futurity and the Maturity in the same year.

Payout

75% payback - \$2,000 added with 100% payback of added money --- 100% payback of Breeders Incentive money at Breeder's Events

Payout: 1D 60% 2D 40%

1st Go – 25%

2nd Go – 25%

Average – 50%

There will be awards through 4th place.

Nominations due: Check Event Entry Forms for payment due dates

\$25.00 PER MISSED PAYMENT. Entries considered late when postmarked after due date. Entries received at event \$50 Late fee. Late entries will run last on Saturday and first on Sunday

Copy of horse's registration papers must accompany the first nomination payment.

Check in Futurity Horse

Check Event Schedule for Check in Times at each event. Please bring required registration papers (copies are accepted front and back) coggins test paper work with to check in. Horses will not be eligible to compete unless they have been checked in.

Owners may enter and ride more than one horse. The owner does not have to ride his or her own horse

Late Entries close for the futurity derby at 6pm Friday night before event

Horse substitutions & Rider Substitutions are allowed up to 6pm Friday before said event with a futurity substitution fee

We will not allow any horse, rider changes or take any more late entries after the 6pm Friday night deadline.

Dress code: Contestants must wear western hat, western boots & long sleeve shirt

Absolutely no refunds for any reason.

The three-gate call rule will be used and enforced. If you are not at the gate after your name has been called three times you will be disqualified. You must be in the warm up pen during the drag prior to your run. Running out of draw order - Disqualification

Futurity entries are not eligible to compete in the derby.

The second go will be run in reverse order.

We will drag after every 5 runners.



SC Productions Rules



ALL FEES MUST BE PAID AT THE SHOW OFFICE PRIOR TO MAKING YOUR RUN. Open Checks and tabs are allowed as long as the office has YOUR check on file. We kindly ask that you close out your checks prior to your run on SUNDAY morning.

Friday night checks will be available Saturday morning. Saturday checks will be available 1 hour after the last horse ran. Sunday Checks will not be ready for at least 1 hour after the last horse runs. All checks not picked up will be mailed out as long as the office has your CURRENT W-9 Form that can be found in the office

All contestants must have a **current W9 form** for the current year on file to receive a check. **Checks are valid for 90 days.** Any checks that need to be re-issued will be charged a \$25 Fee. Any checks not cashed within the 90 days (as printed on the checks) will be considered void and will not be re-issued for any reason.

Absolutely nobody on the ground before 8 am on Friday

NO REFUNDS after pre-entry deadline for any REASON.

By entering you agree to abide by and follow all rules and are responsible for any horse you bring to this event and will be considered an agent for such horse.

Horse/Rider Substitutions are allowed 1 hour prior to the start of Friday & Saturday Open Race with a \$5 office fee per change. Changes for Sunday's Race must be done by 8pm Saturday night. No changes on Sunday morning for any reason. Changes associated with buying a spot cannot be made by email, text or face book. ALL CHANGES must be made in the show office. The NEW RIDER will pay the office fee to the show office and the change fee. ALL changes are required to fill out a CHANGE FORM and new riders must sign release form.

Dress Code: Contestants must wear western boots, long sleeve shirt. Hat/helmets optional

Rerun will be given to those horses that ran with a barrel off set on the marker or incase the timer fails. We will drag after every 5 riders, with the big drags every 50 riders. All reruns will be the decisions of the Arena Director

A horse may enter each race only once.

The three-call rule will be used and enforced. If you are not at the gate after your name has been called three times you will be disqualified.

Only the next 10 riders may be in the warm up arena prior to your run. ALL CONTESTANTS MUST CHECK IN WITH GATE OFFICIAL THEMSELVES PRIOR TO RUNNING OR THEY MAY BE SUBJECT TO Disqualification. If you have a safety issues, please talk to the gateman so that we can work with you PRIOR to making your run. Safety of you, your horse and other riders is in the main concern to us. NO TAKING TACK OFF IN THE WARM UP PEN AFTER YOUR RUN!

No Running out of draw order. No switching of draw positions. HORSE MUST RUN IN POSITIONS DRAWN! – Disqualification

No letting horses roll or lounging horses in warm up arena during the barrel race, warm ups or exhibitions. - Disqualification

Late Entries Are accepted \$15 weekend fee or \$10 per day per horse

75% Entry fees payback & 100% added money. Each race is separate payoff.

Open classes will be a 4D format with ½, ½, ½.

Youth classes will be a 4D format with ½, ½, ½.

Senior Side Pot will be 4D format with ½ ½ ½ ½

Pre-entry draw will be posted on line Wednesday prior to the event

Friday Warm Ups and Exhibitions will be sold on SC Productions Website. Sign up on line pay when you arrive in the show office. You must pay for your warm up and exhibitions BEFORE you enter the arena. You are responsible to pay for warm ups and/or exhibitions you sign up for. Saturday's will go on sale in the show office Friday night and Sundays will go on sale in the show office Saturday night. See Event Schedule for more details

Youth Class will be 4D half second split. Youth age as of Jan 1st (Open to any youth 18 & under as of Jan 1) Youth have the option to carry their times

Senior Side Pot 4D - ½, ½, ½, ½, second splits. As of Jan 1st. Open to anyone 50 & over. You must enter the open class to carry your time. HHA Senior Finals: 1 Run – 4D format – ½ sec splits, \$1,000 Added plus awards to Each D – must qualify to enter see event for more details

Open Futurity & Derby Side Pot: Anyone can enter the side pot. Any age or level of rider is welcome to enter. Horses have to be eligible. 2D Futurity full second split. Open to horses 5 years old and under. The horse cannot have been competed Dec prior year. If proof is found, you will be disqualified without refund. All futurity horses must be registered. Copy of horse's registration papers must be accompanying entry form Derby 2D half sec split.

SIDE POT ENTRANTS! Any Changes or corrections to side pot entries must be made before the end of that race. Once results are posted for side pot changes will not be made to the results. Results posted are FINAL. If we miss you in a side pot you paid for we will refund your money. Please double check to make sure you listed in all side pots you entered.

All horses must be placed in a stall belonging to the arena. One horse per stall. No portable pens. Failure to follow this rule may result in immediate disqualification without refund.

All bedding must be purchased through the MEC. No outside shavings or straw allowed! \$50 fines will apply

A \$25.00 return check fee plus bank fees will be charged on all returned checks.

Any excessive whipping, jerking or tuning in the competition arena will NOT be tolerated. A warning will be issued to leave the arena if not followed by a \$50.00 fine will be assessed.

Riders MUST maintain forward motion! Disqualification

No ponying horses in 30 min warm ups

Exhibitions will be 60 seconds, 1 trip through, tickets sold in the show office at event. Limited number sold each day. You will be allowed to circle 1 time before your trip through *Result in Fines

You may circle once in the arena prior to the start of your run.

Contestants will receive a no time for knocking over a barrel or breaking the pattern

We reserve the right to refuse any entry for any reason. SC Productions have the final say on all rulings.

Everyone will be photographed at these events and videoed. Videos and Photos may be posted online by official photographer and videographer.

NO DOGS IN THE SHOW ARENA DURING THE BARREL RACING COMPETATION.

Hi Point average buckles are awarded on most money won in Each D based on ALL 3 Open Runs and/or ALL 3 Youth runs to be eligible to hi point buckles. In case of a tie buckles will go back to the fastest time run that weekend for the tie breaker. Buckles are NOT given at all events see race details for more information

No selling products or providing a service on the MEC, Double F or R&J grounds without a vendor approval from Shawn or Casey. This will result in disqualification. SC Productions or event facility are responsible for your vendor booth or products or service while you attending SC Productions events.

HHA Finals: NO MEMBERSHIP FEES – NO EXTRA FEES - To be eligible to compete you must have entered 3 SC Productions Classes at any 2018 Born to Ride Tour events. For Example) Fri Sat Sun Open classes, All 3 Youth classes, any side pots or futurity derby classes. You must have entered 3 before Sept 21, 2018 to be eligible to enter the HHA Finals

Pole Bending Rules 3D format full second splits (winner, full, full) Added money Tipped pole will result in a No Time. 75% entry fee paid back.

SC Productions, Sponsors & MN Equestrian Center are not responsible for any, injury, accidents, loss or theft that may occur to You, Your horse or Your Property while attending this event either as a spectator or contestant. Every contestant will be required to sign a waiver form before you enter the arena at each event. We DO NOT have Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs) on site during SC Productions events.
