Minnesota Breeders Futurity & Maturity



The MN Stallion Incentive program is a great way to advertise and promote your stallion. Each stallion is nominated for a fee of \$350.00. All eligible stallions can be previewed on our website at <u>www.SCProductionsllc.com/MN</u> Futurity Page

The Breeders' Incentive

Stallions enrolled in the MN Futurity Program will be promoted on the MN Futurity website, face book, MN Futurity Event Program & all SC Productions Events online programs and printed color programs at the MN Breeders Event. SC Productions will have custom stallion signage on display at all SC Productions Events.

Money collected from the stallion nominations goes towards the MN Futurity Breeder's Futurity and Maturity purse. Eligible Horses (35% Futurity, 25% Maturity). MN Futurity pays back 20% to stallion owners placing in 1st go, 2nd go and/or average & 20% to MN Futurity for advertising, website, social media advertising, administration, awards, marketing signage and stallion promotions. Contestant Breeders Entry Fee will be added to the Incentive purse that will be paid out in Each Go and Average in a 2D format. Custom awards for Open & Breeders Finalist 1D & 2D winners.

Entries are checked for eligibility to compete in the breeders' incentive side pot. All foals by the nominated stallions will be eligible. Stallion owners must nominate on an annual basis in order for foals to be eligible. The **incentive fund** is an additional side pot of money for entries that are sired by the nominated stallions or the stallion himself.

Open Futurity & Maturity

The MN Futurity & Maturity will take place in conjunction with the B. Tuff Barrel Race, hosted by SC Productions LLC, in Winona, MN. Largest barrel races in the Midwest.

Futurity is open to:

- 4 and 5 year old horses.
- Horse(s) must never have entered a barrel race ever (open shows, rodeos, jackpots, futurities, etc) prior to November 15th, 2022. To do so means to forfeit any and all fees paid and elimination from the futurity. Exhibition or "time only" runs prior to November 15th are allowed.

Maturity open to horses:

- * 5, 6, or 7 Year Olds that are not competing in the MN Futurity
- * Open to Any Aged horse by incentive stallions or the stallion himself.
- * Horses that have competed in the MN Futurity and/or Maturity, they are eligible for life.

Copy of Registration Papers with your entry form is required to be accepted into the race.

Check with your veterinarian for Coggins and travel requirements to Minnesota. Owners must have registration papers, at check in time. Check in times posted on the Event Schedule and Facebook Event Page. All horses entered MUST be checked in before you run. Scheduled check-in times are the ONLY times available to check in horses. The owner may enter more than one horse. The owner of the horse does not have to ride the horse.

Horse/rider Changes: must meet all requirements.

• Changes Close Thursday 8:00PM the night before the event. \$50.00 change fee for substitutions of horse or rider.

Late Entries:

Close at 8:00 PM, Thursday before said event. Late fee of \$50 applies at event to enter. LATE ENTRIES WILL BE LAST FOR THE FIRST GO and FIRST FOR THE SECOND GO.

<u>Payout</u>

Breeders Futurity is a 2D format, full second split. Payback will be 35% of Breeders Incentive money + Contestants Breeders Entry Fee will be added to the Incentive purse. 2 Go's and an Average with each go paying 30% and 40% to the average.

Open Futurity is a 2D format, full second split. 75% of entry fees along with 100% of the added money. 2 Go's and an Average with each go paying 30% and 40% to the average.

*Upon the result of a tie, money will be added together and split evenly for payback.

<u>Maturity</u>

Breeders Maturity is a 2D format, half second split. Payback will be 25% of Breeders Incentive money + Contestants Breeders Entry Fee will be added to the Incentive purse. 2 Go's and an Average with each go paying 30% and 40% to the average.

Open Maturity is a 2D format, half second split. Payout 75% of entry fees along with 100% of the added money. 2 Go's and an Average with each go paying 30% and 40% to the average.

Breeders Classes are Side Pots: Contestants need to be entered in the Open Futurity and/or Open Maturity classes to enter the Breeders Side Pots

<u>Awards</u>

Open Futurity & Maturity Awards to the Top 4 - 1D & 2D to the fastest average winners Breeders Futurity & Maturity Awards to the Top 4 - 1D & 2D to the fastest average winners

- In case, of a tie, awards will be given out according to fastest individual time.
- Awards need to be picked up at the event. No awards will be mailed or brought to another event.

***Stallion Incentive Purse** – 20% of Stallion Breeders Incentive. Payout will be based on entries placing in the 1D each Go &/or Average in both the Futurity and Maturity. 100% of all Stallion money will be paid out EACH YEAR. All Stallions will have to renew their enrollment annually each year.

Race Rules

- A maximum of three gate calls will be made, if contestant can't make the run in 3 gate calls, results in disqualified for that go-round.
- Tipped barrel will result in a No Time
- 2nd Go is in Reverse Order
- Futurity/Maturity horses may carry over to the Open 5D. Contestants must designate carry over option on the Open 5D entry form. Designated carryovers posted on the pre draw can not be changed. It's riders responsible for checking their carryover entry and notifying the office of any missed entry.
- You may circle once in the arena prior to the start of your run.
- Contestants are not allowed to sell products new or used or provide a service at any SC Productions Events this action will result in disqualification of all parties involved.
- Rider must maintain forward motion results in disqualification for that go-round.
- Running out of draw order is Results in Disqualification
- * Cordless eye will be used. New batteries will be placed in the timer prior to the start of each go-round.
- * Should the timer fail, contestant will get a rerun option.
- * All Fees must be paid prior to your run Missed payment results in late fee
- * Contestants need to have a current W9 form on file in the show office to receive winnings

<u>Dress Code</u>: Western boots, long sleeve shirt and hat/or Helmet are required in the futurity & maturity classes. Long sleeve shirts with no collars are allowed. Out of dress code will result in disqualification for that go.

Any disputes or questions that arise during the event which are not covered by the above rules will be determined by MN Futurity & SC Production Producers.
