



FAQ:

*** Contestants can only enter the Fairgrounds at Gate 6 – must check in with staff at Gate 6 to get your trailer tagged by SC Productions Staff**

SD State Fairground Rules – all trailers on the property have to pay to park

*** If you did not pay for camping you'll be REQUIRED to pay it at the gate in CASH ONLY! No trailers allowed without being tagged**

*** Day Parking – can park in Lot F and use Gate 4 to get in and out of The Dex or park in Only Reserved Day Parking space on the fair grounds by checking in Gate 6. Lot F is Free to unhook and leave your trailer if staying at a hotel**

- Every Futurity & Maturity Entry GETS (1) Exhibitions in Draw Order on Thursday
 - See Event Schedule – 60 second limit - \$10 Fines if over 60 seconds
- Saturday Exhibitions will go on sale in the show office Friday 7:00pm – CASH ONLY
- NO Refunds for any reason

- All changes need to be done in the show office

- **Futurity/Maturity Changes/Late Entries:**
 - Close Thursday - June 12, 2025 – 8:00 PM in the show office

* **Late Entries** We accept late entries in the show office. You can enter until the last horse runs in each class. We post the 1st late draw in the Open Class when draw 50 in the Open is running. Any entries after the late draw has been posted will be put on the end.

SC Productions Events Learn More & Rules **Class Details below**

- ALL FEES MUST BE PAID AT THE SHOW OFFICE PRIOR TO MAKING YOUR RUN –
 - \$25 fines will apply
- \$25.00 return check fee plus bank fees will be charged on all returned checks.
- W9 form required before collecting any winnings. Checks are valid for 90 days.
- NO Early Arrival Option on Wednesday for any Reason – Fairground Gate Open at 12:01 AM Thursday

- NO REFUNDS For any reason. you can sell your spots less the office fee
- By entering you agree to abide by and follow all rules
- We reserve the right to refuse any entry for any reason.
- SC Productions have the final say on all rulings.

Horse OR Rider Substitutions Rule:

- Changes must be submitted on an Official Horse/Rider Change form in the show office.
- \$5.00 Per day/per change will apply
- Horse/Rider Substitutions Close at:
 - Friday at 10:00 AM – change for Youth and Open Classes
 - Saturday 10:00 AM – changes for Youth and Open Classes
 - Sunday's Classes must be done by 6:00 pm Saturday night. – For Youth and Open Classes
- Side Pots can NOT be sold.
- The NEW RIDER required to pay an office fee
- Futurity / Maturity Late Entries, Horse/Rider Changes need to be done in the show office – Cut off is Thursday 8:00 PM

Dress Code Youth & Open Classes: Western boots, long sleeve shirt. (any long sleeve shirt is fine)
Hat/helmets optional. Disqualification if out of dress code

Dress Code for Futurity Maturity: Western boots, long sleeve shirt. (any long sleeve shirt is fine).
Hats and or helmets are required. Not following dress code rules will result in disqualification for that go round.

Competition Rules

- Reruns will be given to those horses that ran with a barrel off set on the marker or in case the timer fails.
All reruns will be the decisions of the Arena Director
- We will drag after every 5 riders, big drag every 50 riders.
- A horse may enter each race only once.
- In the event of a timer malfunction, rider will get a rerun option.
- Tipped barrel results in as a no time.

- The three-call rule will be used and enforced. If you are not at the gate after your name has been called three times you will be disqualified for that run.
- Only the next 10 riders may be in the holding pen prior to your run. ALL CONTESTANTS MUST CHECK IN WITH GATE OFFICIAL as they enter the holding pen. If you have safety issues, please talk to the gateman so that we can work with you PRIOR to making your run.
- No Running out of draw order. No switching of draw positions. HORSE MUST RUN IN POSITIONS DRAWN! – this will result in a Disqualification
- No letting horses roll or lounging horses in warm up arena during the barrel race, warm ups or exhibitions.
- Pre-Draw will be posted on SCProductionsLLC.com
- Any excessive whipping, jerking or tuning in the competition arena will NOT be tolerated. A warning will be issued to leave the arena if not followed by a \$50.00 fine will be assessed.
- You may circle once in the arena prior to the start of your run.
- Riders MUST maintain forward motion! Disqualification
- Are accepted until the last horse runs in the class. Late draw will be post at Draw 50 in the open – entries after draw 50 will be put on the end of the class

Exhibitions/Warm Ups:

- Friday Warmups and Exhibitions will be sold on SC Productions Website.
- Saturday Exhibitions will go on sale in the show office Friday night see event schedule
- No ponying horses in 30 min warmups
- Exhibitions will be 60 seconds; Limited number sold each day – Over 60 seconds will be assessed a \$10 penalty. To be paid at the gate. We have a lot of contestants to get in the arena. This rule is in place for respect of other riders.

Facility Rules:

- All horses must be placed in a stall belonging to the fairgrounds.
- No using fairground pens – results in disqualification
- **Camping Fees** applies to all trailers on the fairgrounds overnight. This is a S.D State Fairgrounds rule. All trailers parking on the grounds MUST be tagged when you arrive. There will be a FREE day parking designated area for Day haul ins. Only (1) gate will be used to enter the fairgrounds for this event. Day Parking is not allowed to park in the camping areas. All camping parking is welcome to use electrical sites. **Day Parking will be located NORTH END of the Dex Building – Look for Signs**
 - Gate Hours
 - Thursday Gate 6 Open 12:01AM Closes 11:00 PM
 - Friday Gate 6 Opens 6:00AM Closes 11:00 PM
 - Saturday Gate 6 Opens at 6:00 AM Closes at 11:00PM
 - Sunday Gate 6 Opens at 6:00AM
- If you arrive when the gate is closed there's parking at Heartland Rodeo Grounds. Located 4 miles from The Dex. There's NO stalls or pens, but you can tie to your trailer or build your own pens
- No portable pens. No tying horses outside overnight on S.D State Fairgrounds – results in disqualification
- No outside shavings or straw allowed!
- Everyone will be photographed and videos at all SC Productions events.
- NO DOGS IN THE SHOW ARENA DURING THE BARREL RACING COMPETATION.

Vendors:

- Selling products (NEW OR USED) or providing a service on The Dex, SD Fairgrounds, without approval from Casey. This will result in disqualification for all parties involved.
- Vendors are responsible for providing their own tables and chairs.

- SC Productions or event facility are NOT responsible for your vendor booth or products or service while you are attending SC Productions events.

Youth Class

- 4D Format
- \$500 Added Saturday and Sunday Class
- ½ second Splits
- Youth 18 & Under, as of Jan 1st
- Youth contestants entered in both the Open and the Youth Class, the Youth time will carry to the Open.
 - CAN NOT RUN TWICE

Open Class

- 5D Format
- \$2,000 Added Friday - \$2,000 Added Saturday - \$2,000 Added Sunday
- ½ second Splits
- Futurity & Maturity Entries are required to carry to Friday and Saturday Open Classes
- Required to be entered in the Open Classes to enter any side pots or Incentives

Senior Side Pot

- 4D Format,
- \$200 Added Each Day
- ½ second Splits
- 50 & over. As of day of event
- Must be enter the Open 5D class to carry your time to the side pot.
- No late fee to add a side pot to your entry
- No Refunds or selling a side pot entry

Off The Track Side Pot

- 2D Format
- ½ second Splits
- \$500 Added – Sponsored by: MQHRA
- Must be entered in the Sunday Open 5D Class
- Any horse that **has raced** on a race track is eligible to enter
- No Refunds or selling side pot

Futurity/Maturity Classes:

- **Registration papers**

Required when entering a Futurity and Maturity – Entries will NOT be accepted without registration papers. We **do not** take them via Email, text, facebook messenger ect. This takes our team too many hours searching for papers on too many platforms. Mail them with your entry form or attach them to your ONLINE entry.

- **EVERY EVENT – please, send your registration papers. We do not keep your papers from show to show.**

- **Dress Code:** Western boots, long sleeve shirt. (any long sleeve shirt is fine).

Hats and or helmets are required. Not following dress code rules will result in disqualification for that go round.

- **Futurity**

- 2D Format, Full Second Splits
- \$3,000 Added + Awards Open Futurity Class
- Must be present to receive awards
- 2 Rounds – Friday & Saturday – Pays Each Go and Average in a 2D Format in both the Open Futurity and Breeders Futurity
- Open to 4 & 5 Year Old Horses.
- WPRA Approved
- Must roll time to the opens each day
- 2nd Go Reverse order starting with the late entries running first
- Horse must never have entered a barrel race prior to November 15th the prior year. To do so means to forfeit of any and all fees paid and elimination from the futurity.
- No Refunds
- Any Changes made to entry will incur a \$50 change fee – you can sell your entry – can NOT sell side pots or office fees
- **Breeders Side Pot:** are for horses BY current enrolled stallions. Horse will need to be entered in the Open Futurity class to enter the Breeders Side Pot. 100% of the Breeders Side Pot Entry Fee is paid back to Contestants. 1
- 100% of Stallion money will be paid out to Contestants and Stallion Owners Each Year

- **Maturity**

- 2D Format, ½ second Splits
- \$2,000 Added + Awards Open Maturity Class
- Must be present to receive awards
- 2 Rounds – Friday & Saturday – Pays Each Go and Average in a 2D Format in both the Open Futurity and Breeders Maturity
- Must roll times to the open each day
- Open to 8 & Under. (4 & 5-year-olds can NOT compete in BOTH the futurity and Maturity)
- WPRA Approved
- 2nd Go Reverse Order starting with the Late Entries
- No refunds
- Any changes made to entry will incur a \$50 change fee – you can sell your entry – Can NOT sell side pots or office fees
- **Breeders Side Pot:** are for horses BY current enrolled stallions. Horse will need to be entered in the Open Maturity class to enter the Breeders Side Pot. 100% of the Breeders Side Pot Entry Fee is paid back to Contestants
- 100% of Stallion Money will be paid out to Contestants and Stallion Owners Each Year
